Brief History

Beyond Normal Films (BNF) was founded in 1996 as a not-for-profit group to work in conjunction with the Normal Theater manager. The impetus behind the creation of Beyond Normal Films included founding members Charline Watts and Colleen Farlee. Its main purpose was to augment the Normal Theater's regular line-up of classic films by offering foreign language, independent, and documentary films to the Bloomington-Normal community. The organization was advisory. The evolving primary mission of Beyond Normal Films became two-fold: (1) to provide cultural and educational activities in support of the cinema arts in Bloomington-Normal and Central Illinois, and (2) to recommend to the Normal Theater unique international, independent, and documentary films of artistic quality.

BNF, through its Board of Directors, recommended films from which the Theater manager selected those to be screened. These were designated "BNF Choice" films. In addition, BNF gave its members quarterly film screenings called "Cinema Sessions" (named for deceased Board member Jean Sessions). Additionally annual or semi-annual film festivals (originally called Showcase, then the Farlee Film Festival) were held. BNF was supported through membership dues and revenue from advertising space in its quarterly newsletter (a newsletter was not produced every year).

Several factors contributed to the 20-year success of Beyond Normal Films. The community had no other venue for independent and foreign-language films, and not everyone could travel to Champaign-Urbana to see such films. Members' support and appreciation was enthusiastic, and they enjoyed seeing films in the historic setting of the Normal Theater. In later years, however, the availability of these types of films was not limited to movie theaters, with the rise of DVDs and streaming, in particular. Plus people became less inclined to leave the comfort of their homes and their wide-screen televisions, and attendance at BNF Choice and Film Festival screenings dropped.

The Board struggled to address these issues, which were beyond their control. They queried the BNF membership about their preferences in order to recommend to the Normal Theater manager titles which people would be more apt to attend. They added projects to their mission statement. The Board developed the Cinema Arts Project (CAP) Fund. Through the Illinois Prairie Community Foundation, they awarded grants to individuals or organizations and helped support the Asian Film Festival. Additionally, BNF members raised \$10,000 to support funding for the Roger Ebert statue located outside the Virginia Theater in Champaign.

More contentious was the relationship with the Normal Theater management once that position was redefined by the Town of Normal. The number of BNF Choice films declined greatly. Ultimately, it all became too much for the ten-to-twelve volunteer members of the Board of Directors, and after months of discussion, they voted to disband the organization at the end of its 21st year.

Scope

The collection includes some newspaper clippings from 1996 through 2018 about the organization, and letters to the membership. The work of the BNF Board is detailed in meeting minutes spanning 1998 through 2017 and notes from meetings with Normal Theater management. Scrapbooks in three-ring binders compiled by Colleen Farlee from 1996 through 2017 provide yearly overviews of films screened and activities of the organization.
