Brief History

Born in Illinois on 17 July 1838, Harvey C. DeMotte eventually became a prominent Bloomington resident. In 1856 he entered school at Metamora, Illinois, and in 1859 enrolled at Illinois Wesleyan University in Bloomington. At Illinois Wesleyan's 1861 commencement, H.C. DeMotte and Peter Warner each received a university degree and were the first graduates of this institution. During the 27 June 1861 ceremony, DeMotte spoke on "Progress," explaining the progress of improvements in science and art and referring to the great achievements of genius. While in college, DeMotte was "chiefly instrumental" in organizing a literary society named the Belles-Lettres Society. A mere two years after graduating, DeMotte started the university's alumni association.

After graduation, DeMotte was immediately appointed Professor of Mathematics at the school. His teaching was interrupted in May 1862 when Governor Yates requested 200 volunteers to join a Union army regiment. DeMotte entered the army and became First Lieutenant of Company G, Sixty Eighth Illinois Volunteer Infantry. The enlistment was for three months, and in October 1862, he resumed his work at Illinois Wesleyan University. During the War, he expanded his duties to become the first music instructor at the Wesleyan.

In 1864, DeMotte wed Sara J. Kern; in 1865 he became the university's Vice President. DeMotte was in charge of a topographical survey of the Green River region with Major Powell in 1874. Syracuse University awarded DeMotte a PhD *in absentia* in 1877. A life-long Methodist, he attended the church's general conference in 1882 and was an active member of the local Grace Methodist congregation.

In 1884 DeMotte left Illinois Wesleyan to become president of Chaddock College in Quincy, Illinois. Returning to the Bloomington-Normal area in 1887, DeMotte became superintendent of the Soldiers' Orphans Home in Normal. In 1893, he became President of the Central Union Loan Association; later he served as Editor of the *Bloomington Daily Leader* for about three years.

In 1899, DeMotte returned to Illinois Wesleyan as principal of the preparatory department. He regained his vice presidency in spring 1904 and held the office until his death. On 15 December 1904, H.C. DeMotte died from difficulties relating to a heart ailment. He was survived by his wife and by his daughter, Clara DeMotte Munce.

Scope Note

This collection includes a selection of materials presumably collected by H.C. DeMotte such as newspaper articles, music and literary programs, university programs, Methodist conventions, and more. DeMotte wrote several of the newspaper articles, including some publicizing the university.
