On SS Nuevo. Caribbean cruise from Miami.

Nassau, Kingston, Jamaica, Haiti.

Folder 5: Third Trip December 4, 1952 to December 13, 1952

On SS Contessa. Vacation Lines, from New Orleans to

Cuba, Honduras and Guatemala.

Folder 6: Fourth Trip November 17, 1954 to November 28, 1954

On SS Jamaica to Havana, Cuba, Guatemala City, elsewhere.

Folder 7: Fifth Trip November 27, 1956 to December 16, 1956

On SS Chirigue. Cuba, Jamaica, and Guatemala.

Reeder did not get to Cuba December 4 because of the revolt.

Folder 8: Eighth Trip November 4, 1965 for a 6 week cruise

On SS Constitution from New York City to Madeira Island, Portugal, Casablanca, Morocco, Straights of Gibraltar, Naples,

Capri, Rome, Monaco and Spain,

Folder 9: Miscellaneous

Items not clearly identifiable to a specific trip.

Note: Reeder took two other overseas trips (see below) that do not have folders.

Sixth Trip November 29, 1958 to December 19, 1958

On SS Sareola to Havana, Cuba, Panama Canal Zone, Equator and elsewhere. Ida Reeder met Mr. Allsman, another traveler. They were constant friends. The trip was "the best of all her cruises." Cuba fell to rebels January 1959.

Seventh Trip March 3, 1962 to March 16, 1962

Miami to Port Everglades, West Indies, Caracas, Venezuela, St. Thomas, Haiti. Marguerite Close another State Farm employee accompanied Reeder.
