- 1.1 Reading book, contains phonetics, information on famous people, lists of various topics (year unknown)
- 1.2 Geography and compositions book (year unknown) containing cities, rivers, land masses, populations, number of slaves, astronomical geography, and points of compass, writings and poems (year unknown)
- 1.3 Book of compositions and poems, 1855 – 1860.

Note: Would have attended Bloomington High School. In 1911, wed Arthur Wright, a farmer from Wenona.
